

# Swartz Creek Physical Education Policies

## 1. Grading Policy

- Grading Scale based on percentages:  
A+ 97-100      A 93-96      A- 90-92  
B+ 87-89      B 83-86      B- 80-82  
C+ 77-79      C 73-76      C- 70-72  
D+ 67-69      D 63-66      D- 60-62  
E Below 60
- Your grade is based upon receiving your **4 daily points** (for wearing proper gym attire, shoes, and active participation with a positive attitude, effort, and written tests) and on skill and written tests, quizzes, and assignments.
- Daily points will be deducted for not following any of the requirements.
- **1<sup>st</sup> no dress = warning and no points**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> no dress= warning and no points**
- **3<sup>rd</sup> no dress= teacher calls home**
- **4<sup>th</sup> no dress= RIP Room, RIP supervisor calls home**
- **5<sup>th</sup> no dress= “E” for the Marking Period**

## 2. Make-Up Policy

- When absent you must have make-up work to receive your 4 daily points.
- You are allowed “5” school days to turn in make-up.
- Make-up is a written assignment. You read a sports article and write a one-page summary/reaction paper to it. Attach the article to the summary.
- Summary must have your name, date, and hour at the top of the page. It also needs to be legible, and have a minimum of 125 words.
- The assignment for pre-arranged and/or extended absences maybe changed at the teacher discretion.

## 3. Dress Code

- You must use locker room to change into a separate set of gym clothes.
- Tied, supportive tennis shoes are a must.
- No spandex allowed unless worn underneath, and no nylons.
- No hats or coats inside, exceptions for outside.
- Tee or sweat shirts no mesh, halter, tank, torn or half tops.
- Respectable shorts or sweats in length and design (rips, tears are out)
- No suggestive or profane sayings are allowed to be worn for gym attire (alcohol, drugs, nudity, or swearing)
- Jewelry and body piercing must be removed while in gym for safety!
- Students not dressing will lose daily points and may be sent to the RIP room.
- Boys shorts will be worn at the waist
- **Final judgment on gym attire is up to the teacher!**

## 4. Attendance and Tardiness

- Attendance is a must to pass P.E. as daily points are given.

- Follow the student handbook policy for tardiness and absences.
- Medical excuses are required in case of injury, or to be excused for short periods of time.
- Make-up work is required for all absences!

### **5. Class Procedure**

- Students must be in the locker room by the bell.
- Students will be given 5 minutes after the tardy bell to change.
- Warm-up and stretches will be done together in squads.
- Students will do the daily activities planned by instructor.
- Students may participate in regular clothes for partial credit(except for swimming)
- Following class, students will be given 5- 10 minutes at the end of their gym class to shower, change and get ready for their next class. **You must stay in the gym until the bell rings signaling your release.**
- You may not bring the following items to the locker rooms or gymnasium: glass containers, food or gum.
- **Please ask for permission before using any equipment.**
- For security reasons, only gym bags made of a see-thru material will be allowed.

### **6. Class Conduct**

- Lack of participation effort and poor attitudes can result in warning, loss of daily points and possible referrals.
- Mature attitudes and proper behavior are important to insure student safety. Respect yours, school personnel, and yourself at all times!
- Profanity (Swearing) will not be allowed.
- Stealing or destruction of property of any sort will not be tolerated!
- Students using unacceptable language will be sent to the office and a referral will be written. Examples of unacceptable language: sucks, fag, gay, queer, bull crap, and any general swearing.

### **7. Locks and Lockers**

- You are issued a lock and a storage compartment or basket. Use them wisely. If your lock is lost you must pay a \$5.00 replacement fee.

## **Students Expectations for Returning to Physical Education (PE)**

Student must earn a 1 or 2 in citizenship in PE class.

Student must earn a grade of C or higher in PE class.

Student will not receive 3 or more referrals (office or RIP room, or a combination of 3)

- Any one of the above stipulations will be cause for the student **NOT** returning to PE for a 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter.

### **Interventions and Information:**

Teacher and student will meet and discuss opportunity to return – note card will be filled out.

Teacher and student will meet with another PE teacher and discuss opportunity to return-note card will be filled out again.

Teacher will call home and inform parents that student will not be allowed to return to PE.

All Phys. Ed. and school rules will apply to the individual student wanting to return to PE for a second quarter.
